## Tokyo【Imperial Palace East Garden / Asakusa Sensoji Temple & Nakamise District】

After breakfast, we will go to the Imperial Palace and see the beautiful East Garden. The garden includes the ruins of old Edo Castle, a stately Japanese landscape garden, and meticulously maintained lawns and trees framing a backdrop of the modern Tokyo cityscape.

Next, we travel to Asakusa Sensoji Temple, in Tokyo's Asakusa district. Enter by way of the Kaminarimon "Thunder Gate," in which hangs an enormous red paper lantern. Don't forget to look up to see the dragon sculpture under the lantern! Walk through the Nakamise District – a street full of stalls selling souvenirs that forms the traditional approach to Sensoji Temple.

## Tokyo【Meiji Shrine / Shibuya - Shibuya Crossing - Shibuya Sky】

After breakfast, we will enjoy the tranquil atmosphere of the Meiji Shrine, dedicated to Emperor Meiji and Empress Shoken. This pristine nature spot is densely forested with over 350 types of trees and is a place of calm amid turbulent Tokyo.

We proceed from there to Shibuya, known for the Shibuya "Scramble Crossing" which, at the right signal, floods the intersection with oncoming businesspeople, shoppers, and travelers, converging from all directions in a great rush of people that somehow feels both hectic and orderly.

We then head up to Shibuya Sky: the roof of the Shibuya Scramble Square building, where you can take in an incredible view of the breathtaking Tokyo cityscape. If it's too cold or the weather is poor, you can still enjoy the view through the large windows that look out from the trendy lounge area on the top floor.

You are free for leisure in the afternoon to explore Tokyo as you like.

## Mt Fuji【5th Station - Depending on the weather condition】 Hakone【Hakone Ropeway / Owakudani】

In the morning, we depart Tokyo for the Mount Fuji region, and if the weather is in our favor, we will visit the 5th station of Mount Fuji, where you can explore the mountain's rugged landscape and enjoy views of the summit.


We go from there into the Hakone area, where we take a ride in an airborne gondola on the Hakone Ropeway, which offers spectacular views of the surrounding landscape as well as excellent views of Mount Fuji on a clear day.

The gondola lands in Owakudani, where you will have the chance to see roiling hot springs and sulfurous fumes along the trails of the rugged volcanic landscape.

Tonight, transfer to Atami, and enjoy a bath in an onsen hot spring and dinner at your ryokan accommodation.

## Kyoto Breakfast

### Kyoto【Kiyomizu Temple / Green Tea Ceremony / Sannenzaka & Ninenzaka】

Today, we visit Kiyomizu Temple, also known as the Temple of Pure Water. The temple is a celebrated landmark famed for its iconic three-story pagoda, large wooden stage, and trio of sacred streams which each confers a different blessing.

Next, you will be able to experience a formal Green Tea Ceremony – one of Japan's arts of classical refinement. The ceremony is an elegant ritual of hospitality once only offered to the social elite.

Leading up to the temple are Sannenzaka and Ninenzaka; these streets are filled with preserved buildings that retain the character of the Edo period. Many of the buildings now contain shops selling souvenirs and local Kyoto wares.

In the afternoon, you are free for leisure to explore Kyoto as you like.

## Kyoto【Arashiyama - Sagano Bamboo Forest - Togetsukyo Bridge / Golden Pavilion / Gion Geisha District】

In the morning, we head to Arashiyama to stroll through the Sagano Bamboo Forest, where towering stalks of green bamboo packed in dense groves create an otherworldly feeling of awe and mystery as you walk the pathway through the center.

We proceed from there to Togetsukyo Bridge, a 1930s reconstruction of a bridge that was originally built spanning the Hozu River hundreds of years ago. It's now one of the best places to view the natural splendor of Arashiyama.

Next, we go to view one of Kyoto's most coveted sights – the elegant Golden Pavilion. The temple's shimmering golden walls can be seen reflected in the Mirror Pond below, but don't miss the dainty phoenix ornament sitting on the roof!


We will end our day in the Gion Geisha District, a heritage district where stone-paved streets are lined with exclusive ochaya (teahouses). While admiring the old-fashioned buildings, the fortunate visitor may spot Geisha or Maiko (Geisha apprentices) walking between these establishments.
